Tracking wait time instead of wait lists. Government has in the past discredited wait lists due to variance in how wait lists are tracked. Further, the wait time measure is similar to other data projects lead by Health (e.g. - PRRS)

Have broken down SCDP to two streams: consult and extra-staffing support. Trying to reflect significant differences depending on level of support child requires

Also recognize that in many cases child may not be receiving the level of support recommended due to resource levels

We recognize that there are many different service delivery models, such as group, consultation, and one-to-one. Focusing on just the one-to-one group at this time
